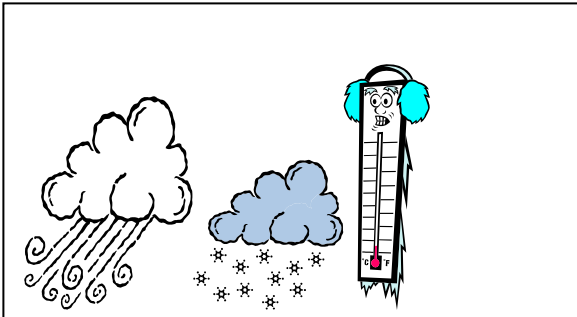


A BRIGHT BEGINNING CHILD CARE SOCIETY
